- 1- Heritage Brush & Tool Holder
 - 2- Heritage Paint Palette
 - 3- Travel Aqua Tote
 - 4- Pebeo Drawing Gum
 - 5- Brush Stuff
 - 6- 300lb Arches Hot Press – 22 x 30 sheet quartered
 - 7- Round Brushes 1 (for frisking), 4, 6, 10
 8. Flat Brush 1”
 9. #2 stiff bristle brush
(Suggested brands: Kolinsky, Escoda or Simply Simmons brushes)
 - 10- Paints
 - Holbein (can be any brand, just not student grade)
 - Suggested colors:
 - Cadmium Red Light and or Deep
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Indian Yellow
 - Sap Green
 - Cerulean Blue
 - Ultramarine Light Blue Light and or Deep
- Maimeri Blu has some luscious colors I highly recommend:
- Indigo
 - Dragons Blood
 - Permanent Violet Bluish & Reddish

These are 4 of the colors I use regularly but if you have your own paints, don't buy more – you can always add to what you have after you see them in class! The same goes with any of the other things on this list. Do not buy them if you already have these items. The only thing that is important is the paper for the first class.
