Suzan Haeni Painting with Gouache

"Art Supplies"

The workshop will include image development, basic gouache techniques, color mixing, and how to layer gouache to achieve outstanding effects. A demonstration will be given showing the step-by-step process of the painting aspects of gouache and how to take advantage of the mediums flexibility. Gouache is an opaque watercolor paint. Whereas transparent watercolors allow you to see the "white" of the paper below the paint, gouache can be applied in solid colors completely covering the paper. Gouache dries to a matte finish it works like a watercolor as well as producing intense levels of rich saturated opaque color. Gouache can be mixed with watercolor.
