

**ALCOHOL INK ON TILE OR YUPO PAPER
WORKSHOP WITH LORRAINE RIMMELIN
SUPPLY LIST**

- **ALCOHOL INK** – can be purchased at Michael's, Joanne Fabric & Crafts & AC Moore. (use a coupon for best price) They come in a 3 pack, choose any colors you like. I suggest two 3 packs. There are several different brands choose whichever one is sold in the store you go to.
(Ranger, Adirondack, Pinata or Artco)
- **TILES** – These are very inexpensive so bring at least 4. You can purchase several different sizes & shapes of tiles at Home Depot or Lowes. 6"x6" tiles to practice flowers. Rectangular shapes are for landscapes
 - **YUPO PAPER** - any size you want to paint on.
 - **ALCOHOL** (rubbing) 91% - not 70%
 - **SMALL ROUND BRUSH** - # 3 or 4
 - **SMALL WELLED PALETTE** - 6 wells
 - **MAKE-UP SPONGES** – wedges (dollar store)
 - **COTTON PADS** – round or square (dollar store)
 - **GLOVES - SCISSOR - MASKING TAPE**
- **CANNED AIR** – Walmart. Target (cleans electronics)

OPTIONAL ITEMS I USE

- Stamper with felt pads also called Ink Applicator by Ranger
 - Squeeze blub to blow air (used to clean camera lenses)
 - Sharpie markers in assorted colors
 - Eye dropper
